Some of these volunteer activities may have an inherent level of risk of injury. Or you may be in other non-physical activities at the theater(s) where productions are presented. Your mental and physical health must be in a condition compatible with participating in LYRIC THEATRE activities.

In consideration of LYRIC THEATRE allowing me to participate in volunteer activities, I agree as follows:

I hereby understand and acknowledge that the programs, activities, and events held by LYRIC THEATRE may expose me to inherent risks, including accidents, injury, illness, or even death. I assume all risk of injuries or illness associated with participation including, but not limited to, falls, equipment injury, contact with other participants, and all other such risks being known and appreciated by me.

I hereby acknowledge my responsibility in communicating any physical and psychological concerns that might conflict with participation in an activity. I acknowledge that I am physically fit and mentally capable of performing the volunteer activity I choose to participate in.

After having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of acceptance of my participation in LYRIC THEATRE activities, I agree, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, to **HOLD HARMLESS, WAIVE, AND RELEASE** the LYRIC THEATRE organization, its officers, agents, employees, organizers, representatives, and successors from any responsibility, liabilities, demands, or claims of any kind arising out of my participation in LYRIC THEATRE programs, activities, and/or events.
